Explanation of the Data: The purpose of this report is to compare the number and credit hours of students taking KYVU courses against the number and credit hours of students taking regular instruction courses. If a student is taking both an online course and a regular instruction course, they are counted for each category. Therefore, the headcount is a duplicated count of students. The headcount percentage for each category is calculated by the category's headcount divided by the total headcount (duplicated) for both categories.
