III. Major ACCOMPLISHMENTS:

- In the committee meeting on 10/22/2010, students were selected for admission to the Integrated Nursing Program January 2011 class on the Technical Campus. In

addition select students were evaluated for readmission into the Practical Nursing and the Nursing Integrated program.

- In the committee meeting on 4/1/2011, students were selected for admission into the Fall 2011 Integrated Nursing Program on the Lees Campus and the Hazard Campus. In addition LPN students were selected for admission into a pilot course in the Integrated Nursing Program on the Hazard Campus. Also readmissions were evaluated and selected for readmission into the Integrated Nursing Program and the Associate Degree Nursing Program.
- Additional meeting is planned for May 16, 2011 to discuss alternates to be admitted to replace students who have declined admission to the Fall 2011 Integrated Nursing Program and to discuss those students who are requesting readmission into the Nursing Program for Fall 2011.
