Hazard Community and Technical College Mission Statement (Review)

Background:

KCTCS Administrative Policies and Procedures 1.2.1 and accreditation criteria require that each college's mission statement be periodically reviewed and approved by the governing board, the KCTCS Board of Regents. The college mission statement is to be consistent with state statutes, the Council on Postsecondary Education's strategic agenda, and the KCTCS mission.

The mission statement was last endorsed by the HCTC Board of Directors on February 16, 2012, as part of the institutional effectiveness process. It was last approved by the KCTCS Board of Regents on June 15, 2012. Per KCTCS policy, the mission statement shall be submitted to the KCTCS Board of Regents for approval at least once every three years.

The Hazard Community and Technical College's mission statement has been reviewed by faculty and staff during the month of October, 2015. After the faculty and staff review, the mission statement was reviewed by the President's Cabinet on October 27, 2015. It is recommended that the mission statement remain as is.

After review of the mission statement by the college faculty, staff, and administration, the mission statement must be endorsed by the Board of Directors. After this endorsement, the mission statement will be presented to the KCTCS Board of Regents for approval.

Recommendation:

Upon review by the Directors, it is recommended that Hazard Community and Technical College **mission statement, as currently written, be endorsed** and forwarded to the KCTCS Board of Regents for approval, effective this 12th day of November 2015 by the Hazard Community and Technical College Board of Directors.
