for the
E.O. Robinson Mountain Fund Intergenerational Training Center

Whereas, the E.O. Robinson Mountain Fund has since 1922 supported the people of eastern Kentucky in the areas of education, health care, and community programs, which have been critical to the success of many programs and initiatives in eastern Kentucky.

Whereas, Hazard Community & Technical College has engaged in the BuildSmart Campaign to raise funds in support of the building initiative the Intergenerational Training Center on the Lees College Campus of Hazard Community and Technical College; and,

Whereas, the Intergenerational Training Center will provide a training facility so that prospective students do not need to drive an hour and a half to receive up-to-date technical training in that the current facilities and infrastructure are insufficient for training the high wage, sustainable career opportunities that are critical to the economic development of this area.

Whereas, the E.O. Robinson Mountain fund has supported HCTC and the Lees College Campus initiatives for over 15 years with giving in the amount of \$389,500 with an additional \$261,300 for scholarship for students at the Lees College Campus and has pledged (conditionally) and additional \$450,000 for construction of the Intergenerational Training Center

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Board of Directors of Hazard Community and Technical College hereby endorses the request of the President of the college and formally requests the approval from the KCTCS Board of Regents to name the Intergenerational Training Center as the "E.O. Robinson Mountain Fund Intergenerational Training Center " in recognition of significant investments made by the E.O. Robinson Mountain Fund.
