Resolution 3-10 Hazard Community & Technical College Honorary Degree Request

Background:

May 2003, the Board of Regents approved Policy 4.17 – *Policy on Honorary Degrees*, which "authorizes the individual colleges to award honorary associate degrees in humane letters (honoris causa) to individuals who have contributed significantly to the awarding college or KCTCS."

This resolution is to recommend *Mr. Bobby Osborne* of Hyden, Kentucky, as a possible recipient of such an honorary degree from the Kentucky Community and Technical College System. - Service as a star adjunct faculty member at KSBTM since the program opened (with acceptance of only minimal remuneration to partially cover travel and related expenses).
- Dedicated professional mentoring and exposure of our KSBTM students in the field on an on-going basis (before, during, and after their graduation from the program).
