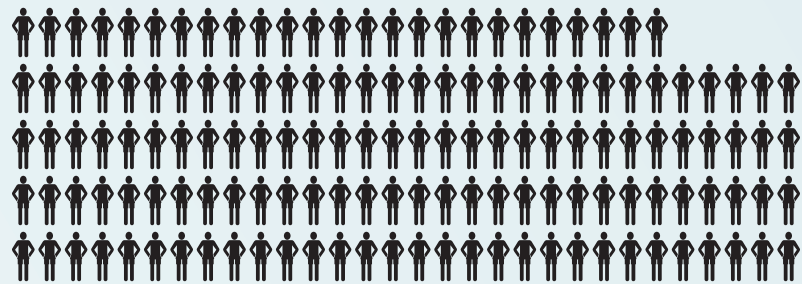

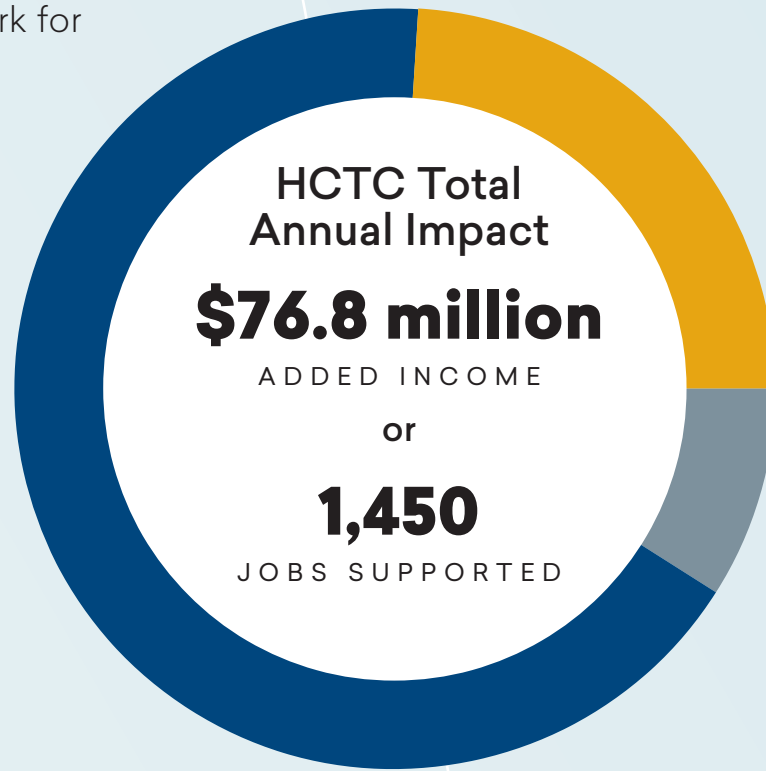
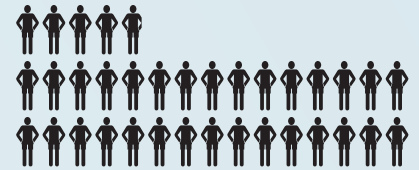
Impact of HCTC's payroll and day-to-day spending

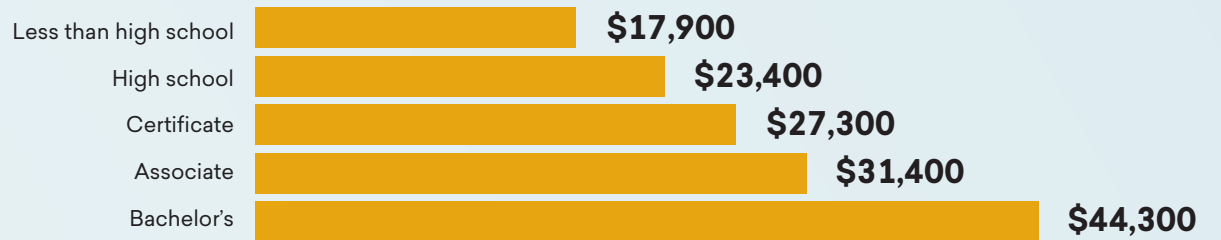

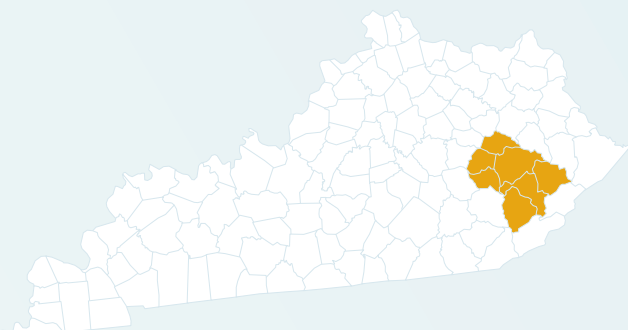
