Students who complete an associate's degree at the community college are not required to complete the MSU HUM 1, HUM 2, NSC 2, or SBS 1 gen ed requirements. Transfer students must complete EDU 201 (or ED 201) and EDP 202 at their community college before they can take their first junior level education course (EDEE 305) from MSU.
