Will other degrees be added?

Yes. For example, last winter MSU added courses toward a Master in Science Information Systems, and EKU added an online bachelor degree in Psychology in 2011. If you are an employer and you foresee a need for our region, please let us know. The UCM tries to be constantly responsive to these educational needs.

When and where will classes be offered?

UCM classes are generally offered in late afternoon and evenings allowing students with daytime work or family obligations to attend. However, a variety of delivery methods are used. For example, some programs are fully online, some are weekend college offerings, some are traditional face-to-face classes, some are offered through ITV, and others are a combination. Students may use computers on the campuses of Hazard Community and Technical College if they are enrolled in online/internet classes. In order to bring certain offerings to smaller student groups, classes are also taught by ITV (Interactive Video) in which the instructor interacts with students via live television. The ITV instructors typically travel to the various class sites in order to have some face-to-face time with their students.

The primary location for UCM classes is the Hazard Campus of Hazard Community and Technical College. However, classes will be offered on various campuses in response to regional needs.

Where are the UCM central offices located?

The UCM service region is the Kentucky River Area Development District which includes the following counties: Perry, Knott, Letcher, Leslie, Breathitt, Owsley, Lee and Wolfe. The UCM central offices are located in the J. Marvin Jolly Classroom Center on the Highway 15 campus of Hazard Community and Technical College. UCM partners and the UCM Director have offices in the UCM complex.

Students may come to the UCM for assistance in beginning the college application process to a four-year institution. Advisors are available to assist in career planning and program selection. Also, assistance is provided with the "how to" of completing admissions, financial aid, and scholarship application forms.

How do I apply to take classes through UCM?

1. Submit an application form to the respective institution.
2. Submit copies of official transcripts directly to the institution.
3. Be eligible to return to all institutions attended.
4. Pay application fees if applicable.
5. Individualized academic advising is available. See contact information on back of brochure.
6. Complete a concurrent /consortium agreement form for EKU/MSU.
7. All LWC application materials are available in the UCM and must be submitted to Billie Robinson.

Will the UCM award degrees?

No, the institution in which the student is enrolled confers the degrees.
