The Special Populations Recruitment Specialist will be a key player in achieving the goals of the Integrated Special Populations function in the Center for Clinical and Translational Science (CCTS) and the DREAM (Disparities Researchers Equalizing Access for minorities) Center in the College of Nursing. This position will develop strong networks with communities of interest (African-American, Hispanic, Appalachian, LGBTQ) with the goal of creating community trust in clinical research and encouraging participation by community members in clinical research studies.

The Special Populations Recruitment Specialist will develop recruitment plans targeting these communities through focused recruitment activities for investigators seeking to engage special populations in their research protocols as research participants. The successful applicant will as project manager on proposal development teams with investigators developing research protocols and grant proposals that address health disparities among these special populations. This position will be housed in the Participant Recruitment Services in the CCTS Trial Innovation Network Core, and is funded by a NIH Clinical and Translational Award received in Aug. 2016.
