Available to African American students who are Kentucky Residents who demonstrate potential for success in postsecondary education

Kentucky Colonels Scholarship

Available to students who are Kentucky residents, must be attending school full-time to pursue a KCTCS associate degree, must be a single working parent, with one or more children under the age of 10, demonstrated enthusiasm for learning and potential for academic success and demonstrated financial need that has not been met by other sources **(Please see Scholarship Office in order to get application)**

Kentucky Coal Academy Scholarships
