

**Hazard Community and Technical College
Surgical Technology Program
Selective Admission Criteria**

The overall criteria of each applicant will be considered and assigned a point value as indicated below:

I. ACT and/or Wonderlic:

ACT scores will be given a value equivalent to the score.

Example: 19 ACT = 19 index points

Wonderlic scores must be the minimum quantitative scores in all areas.

Math – 288 or higher
English – 310 or higher
Reading – 325 or higher

Possible 19 index points

II. Science/Math/English Courses:

Points will be given to completed courses in:

BIO 137 and BIO 139;
BIO 225, or BIO 226, or BIO 227, or BIO 118;
CLA 131, or AHS 115, or MIT 103;
MAT 110, or MAT 150; and ENG 101

*Completed courses with a grade of “C” will receive 0 point each, completed courses with a grade of “B” will receive 6 points each and completed courses with a grade of “A” will receive 10 points each course. MAT 110, MAT 150 and ENG 101 will be combined/averaged for possible 10 points.

Example: MAT 150 – “A” = 10 points
 ENG 101 – “B” = 6 points
 Total points $16 \div 2 = 8$ points possible

III. Cumulative GPA:

Cumulative GPA score will be given a value equivalent to the score.

Example: 3.5 GPA = 3.5 index points

*Selective admission criteria is subject to change. If available students will have the opportunity to utilize an entrance exam to gain additional index points. The information will be posted on the Surgical Technology Program web page before February 1, 2018.
