Tuition	\$147 – per credit hour*

Trajecsyst (web reporting system)	\$150 – subject to change
Uniforms	\$150 – includes white scrubs and white shoes
Liability Insurance	\$11 – per semester

Background checks and drug screenings	\$85 – varies depending on clinical affiliate
Transportation	Variable
