Program Effectiveness Data:

- **Program Completion Rate** (calculated annually): The number of students who complete the program within a cohort compared to the number who enrolled in the cohort initially.

- **Credentialing Examination Pass Rate** (five-year average): The number of graduates who pass the American Registry of Radiologic Technology (ARRT) or an unrestricted state licensing examination compared with the number of graduates who take the examination with six months of graduation.

- **Job Placement Rate** – 2009 through 2013 (five-year average): The number of graduates employed in the radiologic sciences, within twelve months of graduation, compared to the number of graduates actively seeking employment in the radiologic sciences.

This reflects the number of the HCTC/SKCTC Regional Radiography Program students that gained employment in the radiologic science with twelve months of graduation verses the numbers that graduated and were actively seeking employment. This figure reflects an average over a five year span. The program Job Placement Rate has an average from the years 2009 through 2013 of 83.7%. Of the 86 Regional Radiography graduates actively seeking employment, 72 obtained employment in the radiologic sciences within twelve months of graduation. This data is based on the Technical Education Database System (TEDS) Graduate Surveys. The benchmark for job placement is 75%.
